Kenya

The Still Hope Children in Kenya are doing very well. They are healthy, studying persistently, and growing in the grace and knowledge of our Lord.

This year, two desktop computers and two laptops were added to the students' electronic library. Tom is teaching the children to effectively use the new technology.



Widows outreach

January 2020, we began a widows/elderly monthly distribution. In 2021 we added thirty additional recipients to the program, totaling fifty widow/elderly recipients. Every month, volunteers team up with Chris (director of Kenya operations) and distribute food, commodities, and personal hygiene items to the recipients.

The widows we reach are desperate and are physically unable to travel to the center. Because of the goodness of God, this year we were able to build a widow dispensary and clinic. The purpose is to serve the widows in the surrounding area by providing food, fellowship, biblical studies, and skill training. Plumbing and electricity were added to the dispensary and orphanage; our solar panel system is still being used as back-up.

Throughout 2021, the children continued to receive a quality education. Currently, we have nine children in college/university, thirty-six in boarding schools, and thirty in primary.



Our director, Nate Schwenk, had the privilege to travel to Uganda and Kenya this fall to review the projects. The children appreciated his visit, he reported that the children were happy, healthy, and continually growing in their faith. Moving forward we ask for prayer as we endeavor to follow the perfect will of God. We could not do what we do without our partners, and help from the Lord.

Every year we provide a gift for the children and widows in our program. This year each child will receive a warm blanket, umbrella, and sweatshirt hoodie. Each widow will receive a warm blanket as well. The cost averages out to approximately \$40 per child and \$25 per widow.
